The 30-hour Orton-Gillingham Classroom Educator course is designed to provide educators with the knowledge to teach reading and writing skills using a structured, simultaneously multisensory, evidence-based approach at the whole class or small-group level. Teachers learn to design and implement Orton-Gillingham-based lessons involving phonological and phonemic awareness, phonics, fluency, vocabulary, reading comprehension, and handwriting.
